Only 60% of our funds come from the government, the rest is from people like you giving donations and gifts in Wills. Without these, two thirds of our services would not exist, meaning hundreds of visually impaired people would be left feeling isolated and lonely.



## The impact of our work

Here is just a snapshot of our many achievements from one 12 month period:

- Supported over 3,000 people emotionally and practically through our Eye Clinic Liaison Service.
- Provided social activities for over 500 people.
- Produced and distributed over 8,000 newsletters.
- Issued over 1,300 pieces of equipment to make life easier for blind and partially sighted people in Liverpool.
- Provided over 800 sessions within our Active Vision Clubs, helping break isolation and reduce the sense of loneliness for those who attend.
- Supported over 1,200 people through our Rehabilitation team to learn new skills and regain confidence.

We are always grateful for money raised for items donated to help with our fundraising efforts. Here are just a few ways in which we can spend your generous gift:

- £25 would enable 24 visually impaired people to take part in a fully accessible arts and crafts or cookery session.
- £50 would enable 20 visually impaired people to access fully accessible swimming sessions for up to 10 weeks.
- £1000 would enable us to develop and deliver fully accessible Health & Wellness projects.
- £10,000 would enable us to develop and deliver fully accessible high tech projects.
- £30,000 would enable us to purchase an accessible vehicle to help transport visually impaired people to:
  - Weekly social clubs which help to break isolation, create friendships and develop confidence.
  - Weekly gym sessions not only for the health benefits but for the opportunity to socialise.
- £55,000 would enable us to purchase and fully adapt a 17-seater minibus to transport visually impaired people to:
  - Nottingham, where our choir can perform with the only other choir for the visually impaired in England.
  - Take our Active Vision Clubs for afternoon tea.
  - Enjoy the great outdoors by rambling through the countryside.



**As your chosen charity we could help you organise bespoke blindfolded challenges that make great staff engagement events.**

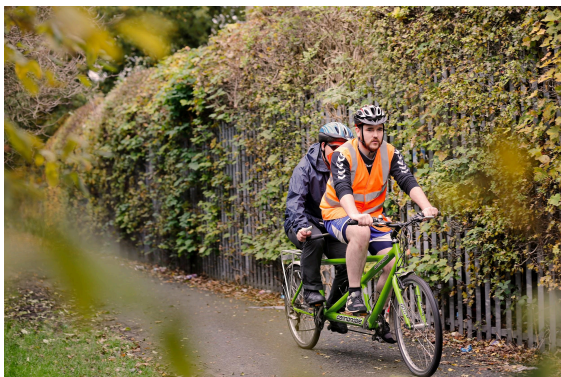
- How about a game of Cricket or Goalball? Or simply a gentle stroll around a local park?
